

# 2024 TE HIRANGA RŪ QUAKECORE - CALL FOR INDUSTRY AFFILIATES

#### **OVERVIEW**

Te Hiranga Rū QuakeCoRE Industry Affiliates are individual stakeholders or industry practitioners that:

- are actively engaged with QuakeCoRE
- are committed to advancing the goals of QuakeCoRE and contributing to the QuakeCoRE mission
- would like to acknowledge this relationship by being named as an Industry Affiliate

This is the annual call for nominations for new Industry Affiliates with Te Hiranga Rū QuakeCoRE.

## **BACKGROUND**

Industry Affiliates are stakeholders and industry practitioners who are actively engaged with QuakeCoRE and who have been granted Industry Affiliate status to acknowledge this relationship. They participate in the Te Hiranga Rū QuakeCoRE Research Programme through attendance at activities such as the Annual Meeting and relevant monthly research area meetings. Industry Affiliates will be advocates for Te Hiranga Rū QuakeCoRE.

Industry Affiliates are eligible to apply for travel grants to attend the QuakeCoRE Annual Meeting, and will receive priority registration. Industry Affiliates will be named on our website and will be reported to our funder, the Tertiary Education Commission (TEC).

Industry Affiliates are not required to complete the Annual Te Hiranga Rū QuakeCoRE Annual Investigator Survey. Industry Affiliates may not apply for Te Hiranga Rū QuakeCoRE funding as a project leader but are encouraged to be involved in research activities as appropriate.

# **SELECTION CRITERIA AND ELIGIBILITY**

**Industry Affiliates:** 

- o may not be employed by a tertiary education institute or other research organisation
- o may not be employed by a QuakeCoRE partner organisation
- will be based in Aotearoa New Zealand
- must have a good standing in industry
- o will demonstrate an ongoing interest and/or contribution to the QuakeCoRE research environment
- must have an ongoing engagement with QuakeCoRE and at least one Associate Investigator or Programme Area Leader

On occasion exemptions to these eligibility criteria may be considered where an exceptionally strong case can be made.

## **PROCESS**

- Anyone that that meets the eligibility criteria listed above that would like to become an Industry Affiliate should contact the relevant Programme Area Leader
- o Programme Area Leaders will complete nomination forms for new Industry Affiliates
- o The deadline for submitting nominations is **Noon on Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> April, 2024.**
