# What

• 1 to 2-year Master's Scholarships for students studying in the field of earthquake resilience, applicants must start this scholarship no later than six months from the date of the Scholarship Award Letter (Scholarship Outcomes will be announced in June 2024).

# Who

- Outstanding undergraduate candidates studying with a primary supervisor that is a QuakeCoRE Programme Area Leader (PAL) or Associate Investigator (AI).
- Students must have graduated or be graduating within six (6) months of the application closing date to be eligible. Applications must be submitted prior to starting their Master's.

## When

 Applications are due by Noon on Wednesday 24 April 2024; no late applications will be accepted.
