What

 3-year PhD Scholarships for students studying in the field of earthquake resilience, applicants must start this scholarship no later than six months from the date of the Scholarship Award Letter (Scholarship Outcomes will be announced in June 2024).

Who

- Outstanding PhD Candidates studying with a primary supervisor that is a QuakeCoRE Programme Area Leader or Associate Investigator.
- Students must not have completed more than six (6) months of their PhD at the time applications close to be eligible. In most cases application will be prior to starting PhD.

When

 Applications are due by Noon on Wednesday 24 April 2024; no late applications will be accepted.
